Notes The student must be familiar with current equipment and have a general knowledge of gas turbine engines and aircraft information systems.

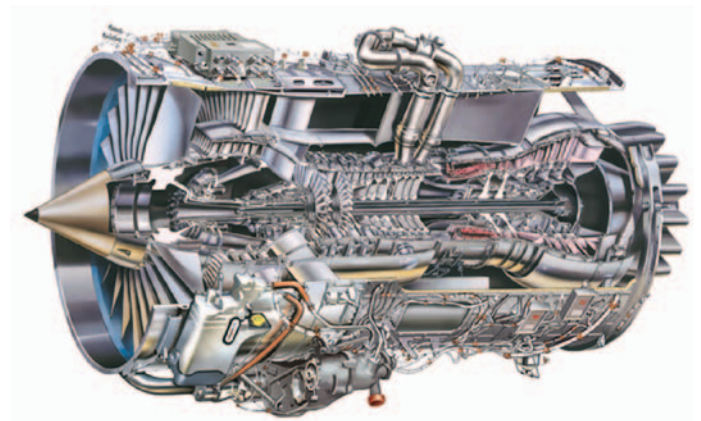
