Notes Students should be engineers, mechanics or personnel involved in borescope inspection and assessment.

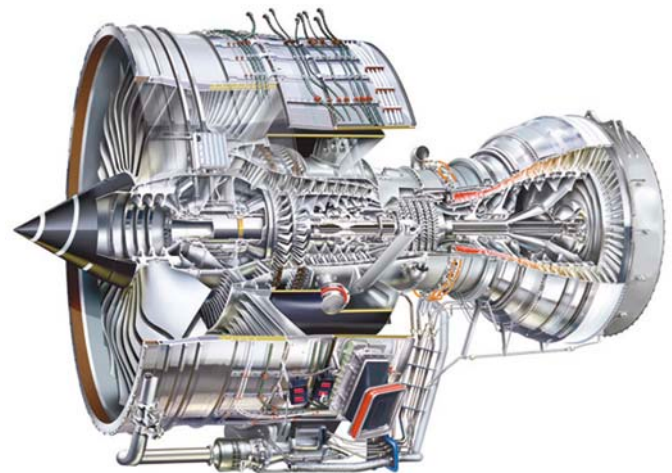
