Notes: Students should be aware of current engine types and have a general knowledge of gas turbines and aircraft information systems.

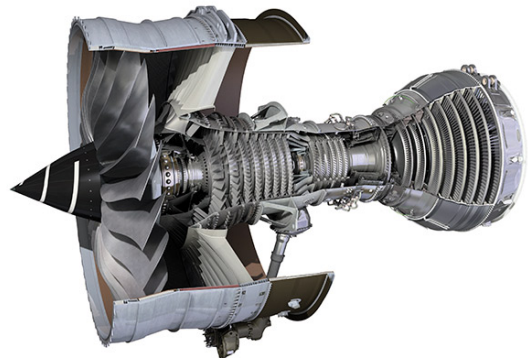
