

# GHG Reporting Guidance for the Aerospace Industry

We have been working as part of the International Aerospace Environmental Group (IAEG) to develop voluntary supplementary guidance on the accounting and reporting of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions for the aerospace industry.

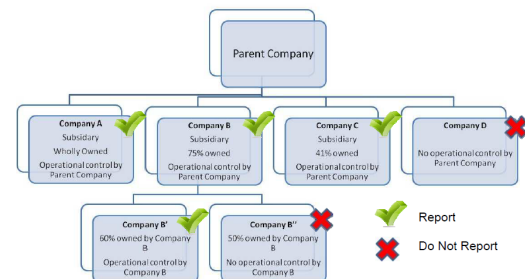
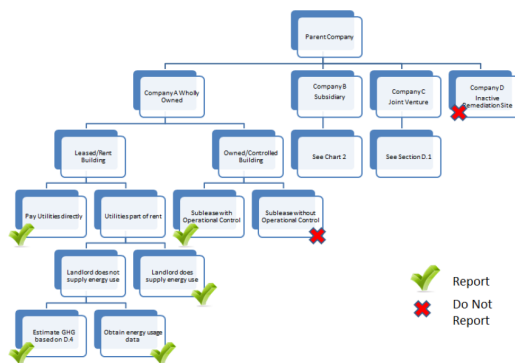


The objective of this guidance is to develop a consistent approach to GHG reporting across the aerospace industry by:

- Setting a common framework of rules and methodologies
- Using common databases
- Having a consistent vocabulary
- Issuing relevant recommendations

This will also enable reporting on the environmental performance of the industry as a whole.

The guidance is designed to work in conjunction with the voluntary GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard, and is intended as supplementary guidance that is specific to the aerospace industry.



As a part of our drive for sustainable growth there is a growing need to be able to understand the carbon footprint of our total operations and global supply chain. Measurement of GHGs is the first step in this process. It enables the identification of the most carbon intensive categories, to prioritise cost effective reductions.
